- These plants are optimally adjusted to the climate, soil and other factors in the region and are competitive in their natural conditions
- Assorted mixtures of regional origin are offered for various locations
- Long-lasting bloom for decades and an even faster bloom in combination with annual flowering periods, richly blooming eye catchers while preserving the regional gene pool
- High ecological value: the assortments often contain between 20 and 40 different species which serve as forage crops for special and rare breeds
